

East Georgia State College and Oconee Fall Line Technical College Agreement for Transfer Articulation and Facility Use

This Agreement formally recognizes the common goal of East Georgia State College (EGSC) and Oconee Fall Line Technical College (OFTC) to increase the number of college graduates in Georgia in support of the Complete College Georgia Plan. This partnership implements a transition plan for currently enrolled and potential students of both institutions to minimize loss of credits and course duplications upon transfer of credits between OFTC and EGSC. Central to the success of this partnership is the creation and promotion of educational pathways for students. In furtherance of the above goals, this Agreement further extends the number of articulated courses between EGSC and OFTC beyond the "General Education Course Transfer List" currently accepted for transfer between the institutions per the "Complete College Georgia Articulation Agreement." EGSC will accept for transfer from OFTC courses listed on the General Education Transfer List if the course is offered by EGSC at the time of the request. EGSC further expands the number of courses noted as *Additional Courses accepted by East Georgia State College* chart, attached.

Purpose of the Agreement

The Agreement promotes the following strategies:

- Assists prospective transfer students at OFTC with the seamless transfer of the general education courses and additional courses as listed herein, to EGSC;
- Provides OFTC students who successfully complete the courses as listed herein and are otherwise eligible for admission, to be admitted to EGSC;
- Assures OFTC students who are admitted to EGSC that the general education courses specified in this Agreement will transfer to EGSC;
- Provide a reverse transfer option that enables EGSC students that transfer to OFTC to re-enroll at EGSC with minimal loss of credits and course duplications upon transfer; and

Cooperation

Both parties agree to extend their best efforts to ensure that the transition from the SACSCOC accredited OFTC to EGSC will be as seamless as possible for the student. Both parties enter into this articulation as cooperating, equal partners with the responsibility to maintain the integrity of their separate programs, to remain true to their institutional missions and to maintain the spirit of this Agreement.

Coordinated Communication

OFTC and EGSC agree to cooperate in communicating with each other concerning the Agreement. Communications may include common publications and announcements concerning their affiliation. Announcements of this articulation and of changes in the relationship will have a coordinated release to the public from both institutions. The institutions will inform and educate its faculty, staff, and specifically its academic advisors, about implementation of the Agreement. The institutions will encourage dissemination of information about programs in this agreement to interested and qualified students, with both institutions providing advising and counseling to prospective students.

Accreditation

This Agreement is made contingent on both parties maintaining all applicable program and institution accreditations, from SACSCOC or other appropriate professional bodies, and in the event of loss of institution or program accreditation by either institution the other institution may terminate the Agreement upon written notice.

Articulated Courses

The parties restate their commitment to the seamless transfer of the "general education" courses between accredited USG and accredited TCSG institutions as shown on the *East Georgia State College -Oconee Fall Line Technical College Course Equivalents* chart, attached. This Agreement extends the list of articulated courses as shown on the attached *Additional Courses Accepted by East Georgia State College* chart.

An OFTC student who successfully completes any of the courses detailed herein, is in good standing at OFTC, and meets the appropriate admission requirements to EGSC will be assured that the courses listed in this Agreement earned at OFTC will transfer to EGSC. A minimum grade of "C" or above will be required for all Area A courses.

In compliance with SACSCOC standards, to be eligible for the award of an undergraduate degree from EGSC, students must earn a minimum number of course credits from EGSC, as set by each degree. Both institutions are committed to advising students accordingly so that credit earned is applied appropriately toward the degree. OFTC acknowledges that

the attached articulated courses are eligible for transfer of OFTC credits to EGSC; this Agreement does not apply to other institutions in the University System of Georgia. Per USG Policy 2.17, EGSC may individually evaluate an OFTC course that is not a general education course, for equivalency and transfer to EGSC.

Reverse Transfer

To ensure that OFTC and EGSC students can seamlessly transfer credits to and from OFTC and EGSC, both parties agree to accept the articulated courses listed herein as equivalent courses for their respective institution, and to award course credit accordingly. Students that move between OFTC and EGSC may do so without loss of credit or duplication of courses, thus incentivizing students to complete a course of study and obtain a college degree.

Regular Review

The Vice President for Academic Affairs, or equivalent, from each participating institution to act as the primary point of contact and agent for this agreement, to speak for the institution and to communicate detail and modifications to respective faculty, advisors and others with interest at the individual institutions. Both institutions are committed to regular and open communication regarding enrollment, articulation and program change.

In the event that either institution elects or is required to amend the articulated courses charts, each party agrees to make every effort to accommodate the needs of the other party such that the articulation can be preserved.


This Agreement will be in effect for one year. Regular review of this Agreement by the Vice Presidents for Academic Affairs, or equivalent, at each institution will occur at least annually from the date of this Agreement. Both institutions agree to provide whatever data is need by the other institution to support the Complete College Georgia initiative and to support accreditation requirements.


This Agreement is subject to the policies and procedures of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, the Technical College System of Georgia, Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges, East Georgia State College and Oconee Fall Line Technical College.


The authorized representatives of each party signify their acceptance and approval of the terms of his Transfer Articulation Agreement by signing where indicated.
