**Course Articulation Agreement
AAS in Business Technology or Business Management to
BAS in Technical Management**

Whereas, Oconee Fall Line Technical College (OFTC) and Middle Georgia State University (MGA) desire to work together to provide for the matriculation of OFTC's associate of applied science graduates into MGA's Baccalaureate degree program in Technical Management, the intention of the Agreement is to facilitate a seamless transition from the specified associate programs at OFTC.

MGA and OFTC agree as follows:

1. This agreement is made and entered into under the Memorandum of Understanding for Course Articulations signed in September 2017 by the Presidents of both institutions.
2. The two institutions are entering into a course Articulation agreement in support of the Complete College Georgia to assist and promote the transferability of Associate of Applied Science degrees to the Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Technical Management.
3. Terms of this Agreement will be effective October 1, 2017. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon giving written notice to the other party. Such notice must be given one full semester prior to the agreement being cancelled. This agreement will be reviewed annually.
4. This agreement is contingent upon the continuation of all appropriate program and institutional accreditations, including the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) and those from professional bodies.
5. Any OFTC student who graduates from OFTC with an Associate of Applied Science degree and has at least 27 semester hours of technical/occupational credit is guaranteed admission into MGA's BAS in Technical Management.
6. Acceptability of transfer credit is dependent upon AAS degree completion. The AAS must contain at least 27 semester hours of technical/occupational courses that will be accepted as the 27 Career Transfer Credit hours into the BAS in Technical Management degree. In addition, MGA will also accept core curriculum

courses in accordance with published policies and procedures. Additional credit hours may be granted at the discretion of MGA in Business Majors (See course equivalents below).

7. Qualified OFTC graduates will receive transfer credit for OFTC courses to be applied toward MGA's BAS as follows:



8. All MGA candidates for degree must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours of academic work with a grade point of 2.0 or better. The academic work must include at least 27 semester hours of upper level core courses in the major field and at least 24 semester hours of upper level electives in the major field.
9. Of the 51 semester hours immediately preceding graduation, at least 30 must be taken in residence or online at MGA. Any student admitted to MGA for the final year must be enrolled for two semesters and must complete at least 30 semester hours at MGA, including 27 hours of upper level course work in the major.
10. All University System of Georgia and MGA requirements for graduation must be satisfied.


