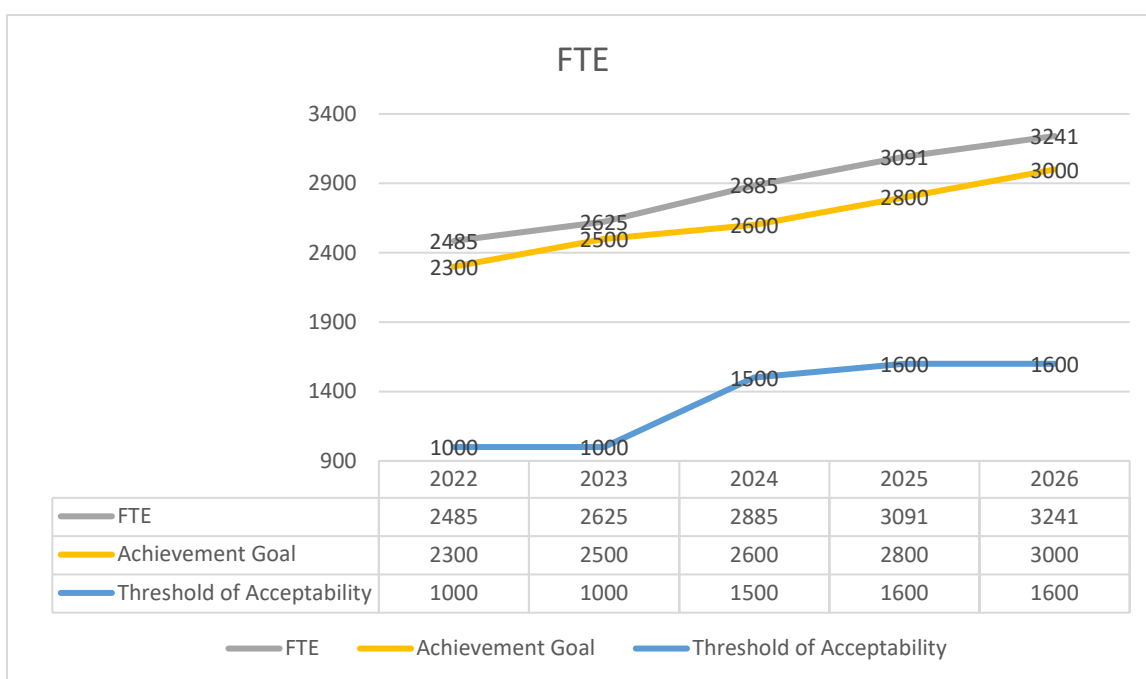

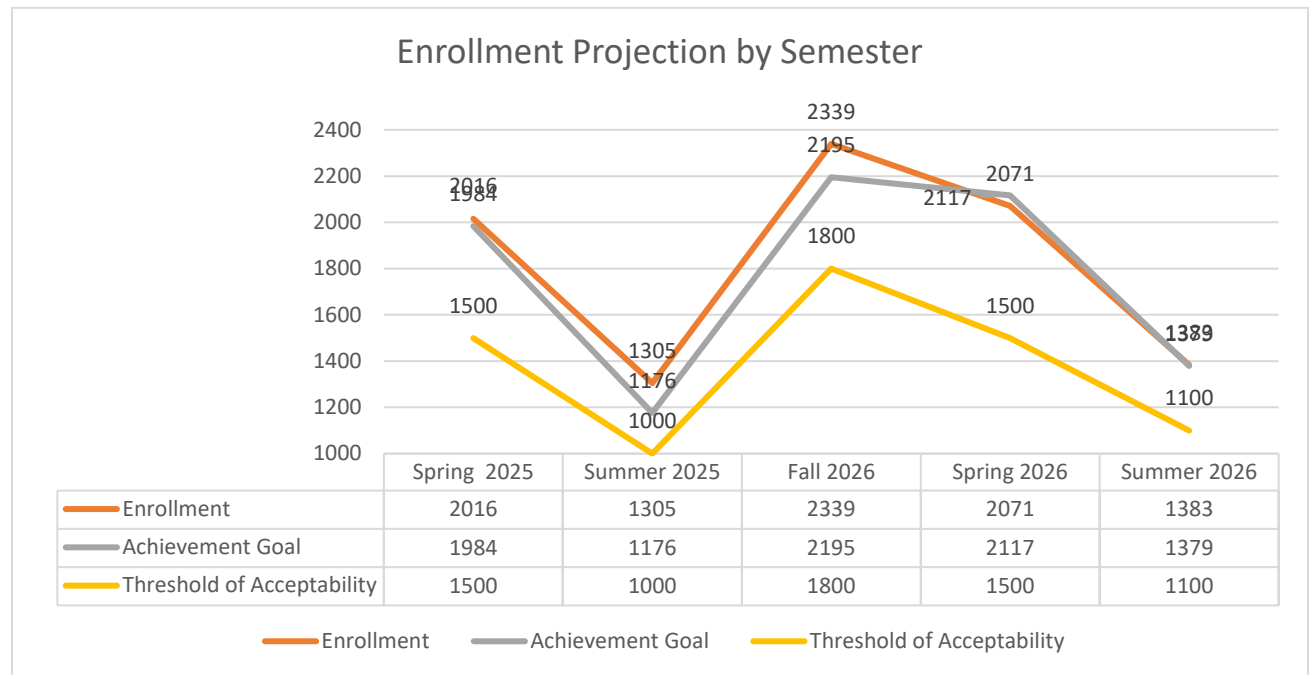
FTE

Definition: Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) is the sum of all credit hours for the academic year (Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters) divided by 30 and rounded down to a whole number. Reference KMS Report MEB0199



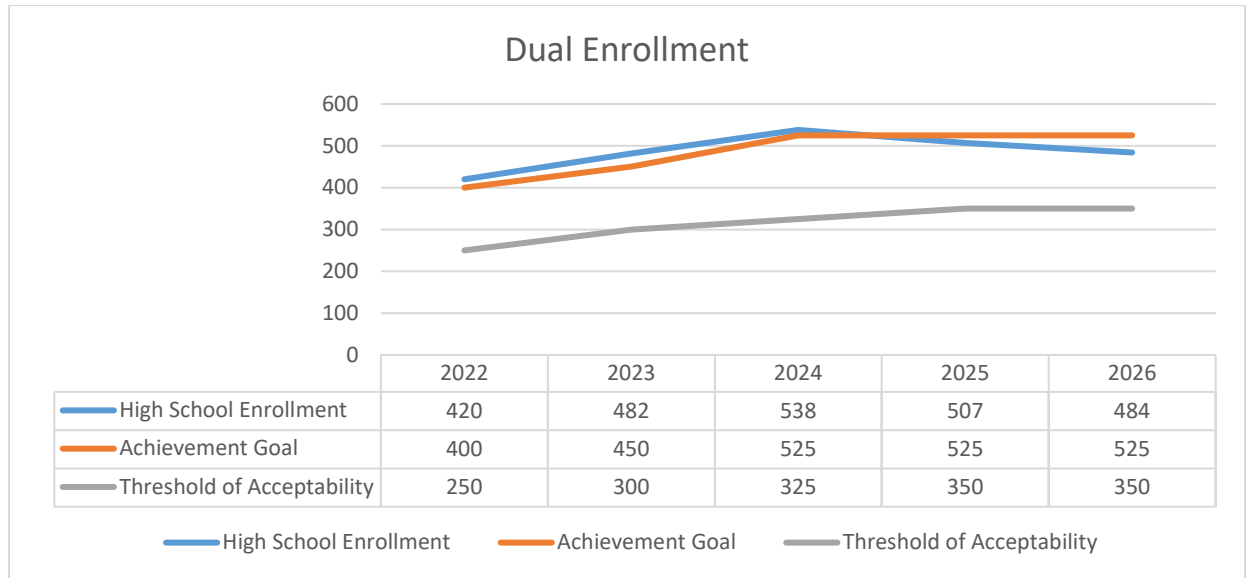
Enrollment Projection by Semester

Definition: Unduplicated count of students enrolled for credit during the academic year (AY). Reference KMS Report TES0550



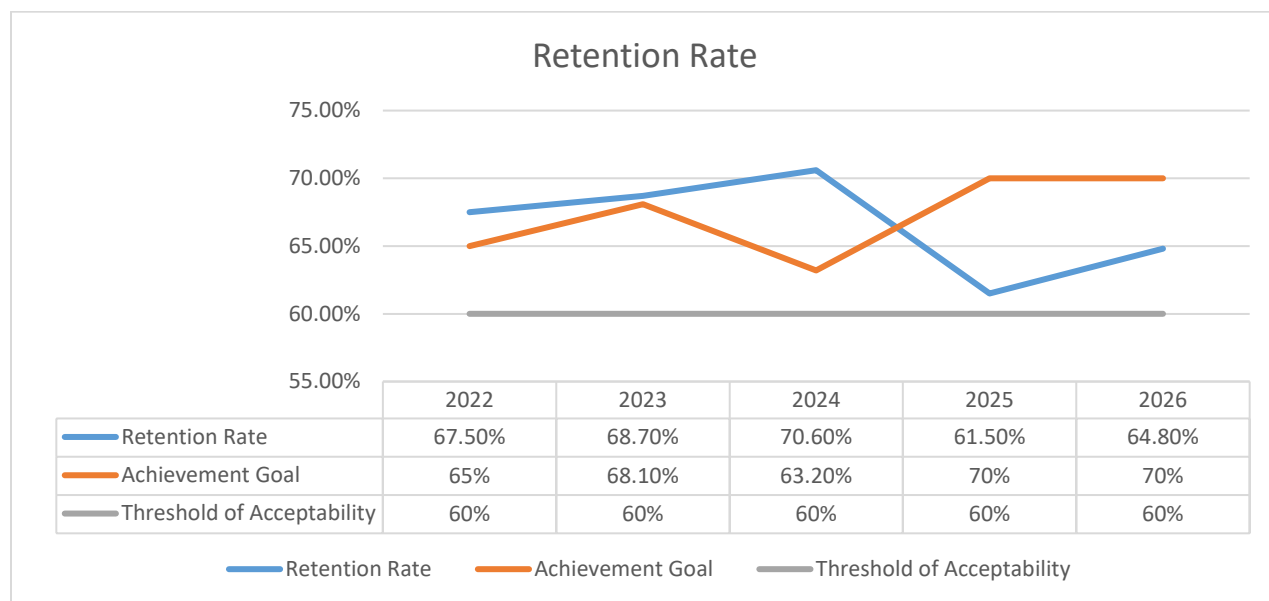
Dual Enrollment

Definition: Unduplicated count of students who were coded Student Type "High School (H)" in at least one term of the reporting year. Includes all dual and joint enrolled students. Reference KMS Report MEB0199



Retention Rate

Definition: A fall cohort is tracked through the following academic year for retained or graduated students. Students in a cohort are retained if they enrolled in any postsecondary institution included in the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) during the following academic year or graduated from any such institution during the two-year period. The fall cohort (denominator) includes first-time students (full-time or part-time) at that college during the fall or summer semester, excluding prior high school dual enrollment. Students must be regular admits only (not provisional, developmental, or special admit) and may not be high school or transient student type. All major codes are included, including students who are not enrolled in an award program, e.g. IA00. Reference KMS Report MEB0199



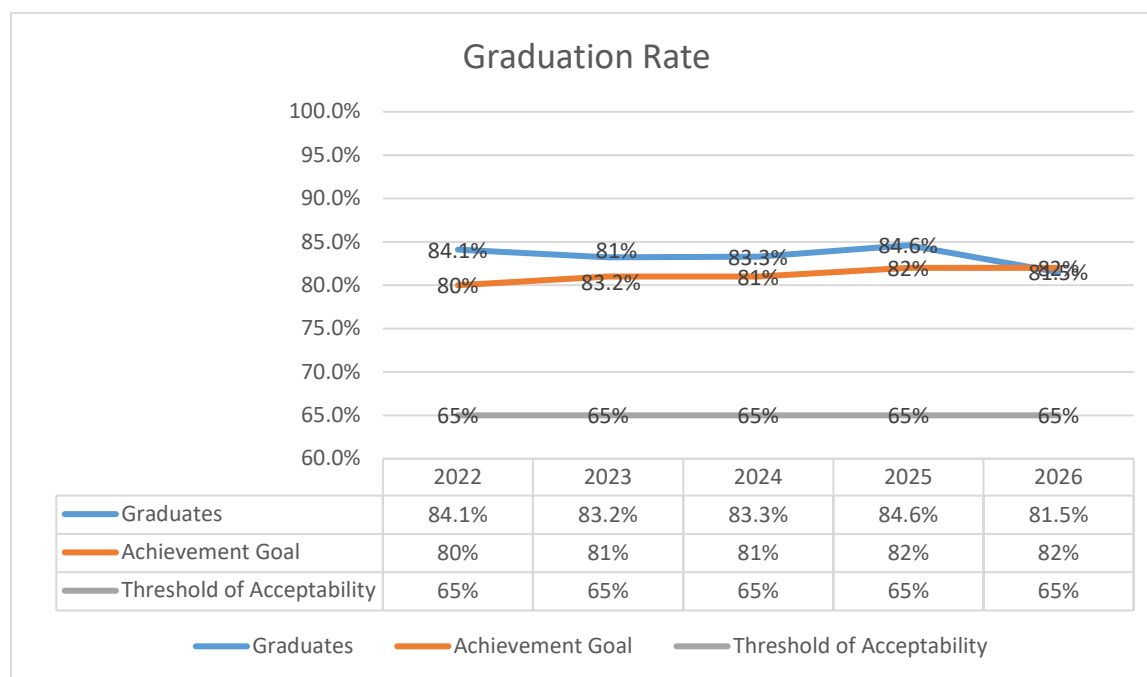
Graduation Rate

Definition: Graduates divided by Graduates + Non-Graduate Leavers*

* Non-Graduate Leaver: during the two-year period took 12 or more hours and did not graduate. The last term enrolled during the two-year period, student was not a special admit, not student type Transient, the primary major was in a program major (not DV00, IA00, SP00 or TR00), student had enrolled in at least one vocational course that was not subject 'SCT' and not 'COMP', and the student was not enrolled at that college both Spring Semester and Summer Semester of the second year.

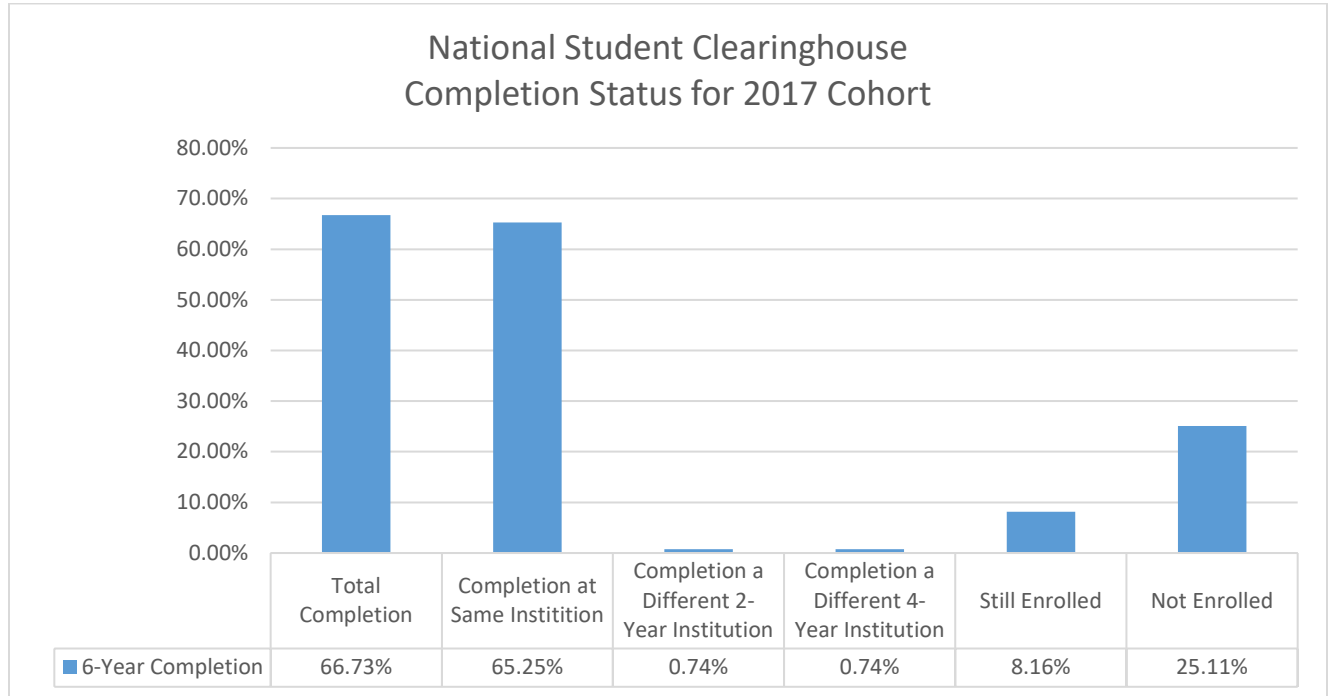
Each student is reported as a Leaver exactly once, based on their home campus and major the last term enrolled during the two-year period.

Each student is reported as a Graduate exactly once at the college level, once for each campus (so if a student received an award at more than once campus, he or she is counted once for each of those campuses), and once for each major (students are counted once for each award they received). So a sum of graduates by campus, or a count of graduates from the student details, will be more than the college's unduplicated total. Reference KMS Report TES3111



6-Year National Student Clearinghouse Total Completion Rate

Definition: Of the first-time credential-seeking students who started at the institution in 2017, the percentage who received a credential at OFTC or another institution or are still enrolled. Reference NSC Research Center Student Tracker Postsecondary Completions



Job Placement

Definition: The placement rate tracks a cohort of graduates through September 15 of the following year and uses the latest employment status entry for each student. The rate is calculated as follows:

Numerator: Employed in Field + Military+ Employed in Related Field + Employed in Unrelated Field + Employed in Field & Continuing Education + Employed in Related Field & Continuing Education + Employed in Unrelated Field & Continuing Education + Continuing Education. Denominator: Numerator + Not Employed. Reference KMS Report MEB0199
